



How To Park at Loblaws

We have often mentioned that the underground garage at Loblaws (corner of Rideau and Nelson) is a good and inexpensive place to park when you're coming to a ByTowne movie.

Loblaws management has told us, though, that they're having a problem. Paid parking is a much lower priority for them than offering lots of convenient parking for their customers while they shop. Movie patrons are leaving their cars for two-plus hours in spots that should be turning over rapidly for grocery shoppers.

So Loblaws has asked us to convey to movie patrons that they and their parking lot managers, Target Park, will be enforcing the following rules:

- Cars parked for grocery shopping (under 2 hours) may park on **LEVEL 1** (red markings on pillars)
- Cars parked for 2 hours or more must park on **LEVEL 2** (down one level, blue markings on pillars). Buying a few items upstairs after the movie doesn't change things; what matters is how long you're in the lot. Fees vary; check with the attendant if in doubt.
- Cars parked for more than two hours on **LEVEL 1** will be ticketed.

Tip: drive all the way down to the end of Level 2 for easy access to the well lit pedestrian exit ramp. You're closer to the ByTowne than you think!

Parking is safe, convenient and inexpensive at the Loblaws garage. Please help us keep our neighbours and friends happy by respecting their rules.
